Meet Police Chief Mike Healy



The City is happy to announce that Mike Healy, who has been the Interim Police Chief of Mt. Angel since November 2010, has accepted our offer to stay with the City long-term. Here is a little bit about him.

Mike Healy became interested in police work at a young age; he was inspired by two of his neighbors who were in law enforcement. He respected them, thought the job sounded exciting and different from the usual office environment. Chief Healy started as a cadet in the City of Stayton, was promoted several times and became the Chief there in 1993. He graduated from the 169th session of the FBI National Academy at Quantico.

He began as Police Chief in the City of Lebanon in 1998. Mike retired for a whole six months before he was asked to come in as interim chief here in Mt. Angel. Having attended Oktoberfest for years, he was intrigued to work for the City. Chief Healy's goals for the Police Department are to achieve consistency of approach and appearance for the department and to work with the officers on their career development.
