## Look at the new Taylor Street!



On May 17<sup>th</sup> the City overlaid Taylor Street from Sheridan to Oak and from Elm to Birch Streets. The City Council put a great deal of effort into allocating funds toward this project and we are excited to accomplish this goal.

The Council made improvements to Taylor Street a priority in the budget in the last year and the Budget committee and Council are considering four more street/sidewalk projects in the coming year's budget: 1) Taylor Street overlay from Sheridan to Garfield and Birch to Alder which would complete the Taylor Street overlay, 2) Elm Street overlay from Marquam to College Street, 3) sidewalk repair and replacement on both sides of Taylor from Elm to Alder, (continued on next page)

And 4) repair and replacement of sidewalk on the south side of W. Marquam Street from Lincoln to the city limits.

In addition to these four projects the Budget Committee and Council are considering a 50/50 sidewalk repair program in which property owners could get help paying for half the cost of sidewalk repairs in front of their property.

These projects will be voted on and the final budget is scheduled to be adopted at the June 4<sup>th</sup> Council meeting. There are also many other projects being considered in this year's budget so feel free to check out the proposed budget on our website or peruse the document at City Hall. ## **Updates on Saalfeld Family Park**

The design of Saalfeld Family Park was approved in March and in April most of the existing vegetation was removed and paver bricks stored so the area can be re-graded. The Oktoberfest Board has generously donated labor and equipment to make this happen. The second phase this month is to install hardscapes (irrigation and pathways) as well as some new vegetation.
