
Please join the team to pick the design of the site. This will only take a few hours of your time and we would greatly appreciate your input on making this new website a success.

## CITY COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2012

Now is the time to begin the process for those interested in running for City Council. On November 6, 2012, the citizens of Mt. Angel will vote to fill the Mayor position and three City Councilor positions (Mayor Rick Schiedler, Councilors Darren Beyer, Kelly Grassman and Andrew Otte are eligible for re-election). A person seeking office must be a resident of Mt. Angel for one year previous to the election and must collect 20 signatures from registered voters. Candidacy forms are available at City Hall or online at the Secretary of State's website. The earliest date to file is July 9<sup>th</sup> and election materials should be returned to the City by August 18<sup>th</sup> for certification. The filing fee is \$5.
