## City Council Passes Budget with Community Goals in Mind

The Mt. Angel City Council approved the 2012-2013 budget on June 18<sup>th</sup> and these are some of the projects and programs budgeted for this year from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 through June 30, 2013:

- Taylor Street Overlay from Birch to Alder and Garfield to Sheridan
- Elm Street Overlay
- W. Marquam Sidewalk completion
- Taylor Street Sidewalk replacement
- Continued funding of a Seasonal Parks Worker position
- Continued funding of the School Resource Officer position
- Increased funding of the Sewer Lateral Repair Program
- 50/50 Sidewalk Repair Program
- Updated Public Works equipment
- Updated Police Department communications equipment

### **Candidate Filing Information**

On November 6, 2012, the citizens of Mt. Angel will vote to fill the Mayor position and three City Councilor positions. To be eligible for office you must be a resident of Mt. Angel for one year immediately prior to the election and can file for candidacy by submitting the filing fee of \$5 or by collecting 20 signatures from registered Mt. Angel voters. Candidacy forms are available at City Hall or online at the City website or the Secretary of State's website. Election materials should be returned to the City by August 18<sup>th</sup> for certification and the final acceptance date is August 28<sup>th</sup>.
