City Receives Grant for a \$243,000 project at Ebner Park

From your Mayor and City Council---

It is our pleasure to announce that the City received a grant from the Oregon Department of Parks and Recreation for a quarter of a million dollar project at Ebner Park. In the next year or so, we will have new playground equipment, benches, bike racks, a new drinking fountain, a new basketball court, a soccer field with overhead lighting, landscaping, a hard surface path in the park and soft surface walking trail around the perimeter of the park. This design comes directly from our parks master plan based on community workshops.

As a community, we came together to develop a master plan, as a Council, we set aside match money for the grant, and made parks a priority and several Councilors contributed to our application. The City's application and presentation to the grant committee highlighted the fact that we as a City have a community built on volunteerism.

The hard work of this City Council, the efforts of Oktoberfest, the work of Pepsi NW Beverages and others told the story that enabled us to get this grant. Thanks to everyone for helping us bring this grant money, and this next great park project to Mt. Angel.

As we move forward with this project, we will continue to provide information on any impacts of construction.
