Update on Ebner Park Improvement Project

The City anticipated major improvements in Ebner Park this summer to build a new soccer field, basketball court, playground, walking trail and other amenities. We would like to let everyone know that the project will be postponed until construction season in the spring. While we were hoping to do the construction this year, in order to ensure a great product for the community we are taking some time to make sure it is designed for appropriate drainage and that the improvements are done well. The new timing does not impact the city's grant funding from the State of Oregon. One benefit of this change is that Ebner Park is reopened for the summer and fall, and available for reservations including for softball events and Oktoberfest.
