Residence of Mt. Angel  
Anyone recycling at the Republic Services Clean Up must show driver's license with a Mt. Angel address as residence.



***CLEAN UP!***

**Acceptable Yard Debris:**

Shrubs, grass clippings, tree/shrub trunks no bigger than 6" in diameter, clean wood (unpainted, unvarnished, etc.)

**Unacceptable Yard Debris:**

Dirt, trunks bigger the 6" in diameter, painted or treated wood.

**Acceptable Metal Items:**

Major Appliances (all Freon units: fridges, freezers and air conditioners incur \$25 disposal charge), steel, aluminum, bike frames, bed frames, wire fencing, and other metal ONLY items. We can accept E-Cycling, this includes TV's, computer monitors and towers,

**Unacceptable Metal Items:**

VCR's, Stereo's or electronics and other items that are not metal.
