Save your white laundry!

Each year the City flushes all the water lines in town. We do this maintenance to keep the lines clean and ensure that the water quality remains high. The Public Works Department will be flushing the lines during the month of October, starting with the east side of town and working over to the western half of Mt. Angel. The Public Works crew will put up a sandwich board sign when they are flushing the lines in your area so look out for that if you are doing laundry during the day from 9am to 4pm. Keep in mind that particulates in the water are safe but can cause a dingy appearance to clothing washed in water during the flushing. The solution to avoid having your laundry discolored is to run the water from any faucet inside the house until it runs clear before washing. If you do notice a dingy color in your laundry we suggest rewashing the load before drying the clothing. Please call Public Works if you have any questions at 503-845-6260.



Thinking of remodeling your home or building a shed in the backyard?

If you live in Mt. Angel city limits and you would like to build or make structural changes to an existing building, most likely you will need a building permit. The City of Mt. Angel and Marion County are both involved in the permit process. For electrical, mechanical, and plumbing permits you may submit either at City Hall or Marion County and can get these permits issued over the counter the same day. For structural/building permits you will submit at the City and the plans will be reviewed by the Marion County Building Inspection Department before the permit can be issued. For residential building permits you will need two copies of your plans and you'll want to allow some extra time for this process before you can start building.
