Woodburn Interchange and Transit Facility Project Underway

The Woodburn Interchange and Transit Facility project is addressing both traffic flow and safety concerns in the busy interchange of I-5 and Oregon 214/219 by constructing a variety of improvements. Some on-the-ground preparation work has started and major construction beginning summer 2013.

What improvements are included in the project?

The project will improve the existing interchange and add a transit/park and ride facility. The improvements are designed to safely accommodate multi-modal travel needs for the next 20 years. The project includes:

- A reconstructed interchange over I-5 with gateway design enhancements
- Evergreen Transit/Park and Ride facility
- Evergreen Road extension
- Sound walls
- Highway 214/219 improvements
