New Employee Profile: Nann Fleck

Please join in on August 5th at the corner of Garfield St. and E. Charles St. from 6-8pm. Bring your favorite side dish.



City Charter Revision and Update

Earlier this year, the City Council commissioned an advisory committee to review and update the City Charter. Similar to the state or federal Constitution, the Charter sets out the primary framework for how the city is governed. For example, the Charter specifies the membership of the city council, identifies the powers of the mayor and councilors, specifies other appointed officers of the city, and determines the powers of the city council and the city in general. The current Mt. Angel City Charter was last updated in 1982. Since then, changes in state law have overridden some provisions of the Charter while other provisions are simply out of date. The new Charter was designed based on the 2010 Model Charter for Cities prepared by the League of Oregon Cities. A charter must be approved by the city electorate and the City Council has called for an election on the new Charter on November 4th. City Council Election Packets Available

City Council Election packets are now available to run for Mt. Angel Mayor or City Councilor. Under the Mt. Angel Charter, the mayor serves a two year term. City councilors serve a four year term. To qualify for the ballot, the candidate information packet contains all the details and can be picked up at City Hall.
