

**CITY OF MT. ANGEL
RESOLUTION NO. 1463**

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A RATE INCREASE OF 11.8% TO REPUBLIC SERVICES OF MARION COUNTY, OREGON (FORMERLY ALLIED WASTE OF MARION COUNTY, OREGON) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FRANCHISE APPROVED AS ORDINANCE 704.

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2005, the Mt. Angel City Council adopted Ordinance No. 704 renewing the franchise of Allied Waste Services of Marion County, Oregon to continue providing all types of solid waste collection, resource recovery, and disposal of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of said ordinance provides that rates for the Franchisee may be changed by the passage of a Council Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Franchisee, now recognized by the City of Mt. Angel as Republic Services of Marion County, Oregon per Resolution 1415 adopted by the Mt. Angel City Council October 7, 2013, applied to the City for an increase in rates in September of 2016, stating the organization is unable to cover increased cost of disposal; and

WHEREAS, Marion County has increased the disposal rates for municipal solid waste due to declining revenues and increased expenses as a result of a recent change in the way electrical markets are valued and a decline in metal prices; and

WHEREAS, Marion County is a flow controlled County, requiring all solid waste produced in Marion County be disposed of within said County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Angel that:

SECTION 1. The request of Republic Services of Marion County, Oregon for a rate increase to defray the increased cost of disposal is approved at 11.8%, and the City adopts the attached rate schedules labeled as Exhibit "A", being incorporated by reference in this resolution. The rates approved shall be maximum rates, effective October 1, 2016.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by Council.


