New Business License for 2017

On October 3rd, the City Council approved an ordinance requiring all businesses to obtain a business license at the beginning of each calendar year. The object of the business license is to gain an understanding of who is doing business in Mt. Angel, what the nature of the business is, to ensure that business is conducted in a safe environment in order to protect workers and patrons and assist first responders in responding appropriately, and to certify compliance with all City ordinances and resolutions. A "Business" includes an individual, shop, firm, company, corporation, association or partnership conducting any trade, profession, occupation or pursuit for gain. This definition includes, but is not limited to, non-profit organizations which sell food or liquor, transient merchants, and home occupations. The cost of the annual permit is \$50. Applications will be made available in the coming month on the City website <http://www.ci.mt-angel.or.us/> and at City Hall.
