Development Code is Being Updated

The City was provided a Transportation Growth Management Grant last year by the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), to update the Mt. Angel Development Code. The grant provided the City with a consultant from Angelo Planning Group and together, along with the DLCD's assistance, a draft code was developed based upon the input of various community stakeholders, the Planning Commission, and City Council.

A public hearing will be held on Thursday, December 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the Mt. Angel Community Room, 290 East Charles Street to review the proposed code amendments and provide an opportunity for public comment. At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to the Mt. Angel City Council regarding the proposed amendments. The City Council will conduct a second public hearing to consider adoption of the proposed amendments and receive public comment. That hearing is scheduled for Monday, February 6, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Mt. Angel City Community Room, 290 East Charles Street.
